Italy's Amalfi Coast 4/12/2025

Day 1: Naples Arrive in Naples at any time. Meet your group for a welcome meeting around 6:00 or 7:00 p.m.

You may arrive in Naples at any time today. The nearest airport is the **Naples-Capodichino International Airport (NAP)**. You can also consider flying to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport (FCO), transferring to Roma Termini, and taking a 1.5-hour train from Rome to Naples for approximately €60–70 one way (including the Leonardo Express train from the airport to Roma Termini); [contact us](#) for more information. Due to the potential for flight delays or cancellations—and to give you more time to explore the area—we recommend that you consider arriving in Italy at least a day in advance. This will also give you time to adjust to the time difference and overcome any jetlag. We can book extra hotel nights for you in Madrid before and/or after the trip. Please note that check-in at the hotel is usually around 2:00–3:00 p.m. There are no planned activities until an intro meeting around 6:00 or 7:00 p.m., usually in the hotel lobby. Check for a sign or ask at the reception desk about the exact time and location of the group meeting. Please make every effort to arrive in time for this meeting. If you are delayed and will arrive late, please inform us. Your tour leader will then leave you a message at the front desk informing you of where and when to meet up tomorrow. After the meeting, you might choose to have dinner at a nearby pizzeria with your traveling companions and your tour leader to get to know one another further.

Day 2: Naples to Sorrento Coast (B) Start the day off with an orientation walk of Naples. Stroll past sites like Spaccanapoli, Castell'Ovo, Castel Nuovo Maschio Angioino, Galleria San Carlo, Piazza del Plebiscito and the Royal Palace. Then the group will travel to Sorrento Coast. In the evening attend a limoncello tasting and after set out on an orientation walk of Sorrento with your tour leader.

Day 3: Sorrento (B) Enjoy a free day in Sorrento. Maybe set out for an optional excursion to Capri island by hydrofoil and take a stroll through the town while admiring the blue water and striking limestone sea stacks.

Day 4: Sorrento Coast to the Amalfi Coast (B) Spend the day travelling from the Sorrento Coast to the Amalfi Coast. Pass through the towns of Amalfi and Ravello taking in the dramatic views and searching for lemon groves wherever you go.

Day 5: Amalfi Coast (B) Transfer to Bomerano di Agerola along the coast and begin to walk The Path of the Gods. The group will hike 8.6km to Positano and then return to our hotel to rest and enjoy free time from a long day hiking along the Amalfi Coast.

Day 6: Amalfi Coast to Naples (B) Leave the Amalfi Coast behind and travel north back to Naples today. Along the way the group will stop in Pompeii for a guided excursion. Enjoy an evening of free time in Naples.

Day 7: Naples (B) Depart Naples at any time.

There are no planned activities today, so you may depart Naples at any time. The nearest airport is **Naples-Capodichino International Airport (NAP)**. You can also consider flying to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport (FCO), transferring to Roma Termini, and taking a 1.5-hour train from Rome to Naples for approximately €60–70 one way (including the Leonardo Express train from Roma Termini to the airport); [contact us](#) for more information.
