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## GEEO ITINERARY

Philippines Express 3/22/2027

**Day 1: Puerto Princesa Arrive in Puerto Princesa at any time. Meet your group for a welcome meeting around 6:00 or 7:00 p.m. Evening mangrove excursion to see fireflies illuminating night sky.**

**Arrive at any time.** There are no planned activities until the Welcome Meeting in the evening. The nearest airport is **Puerto Princesa International Airport (PPS)**.

Consider arriving 1-2 days early to explore the city, adjust to the time zone, and buffer against flight delays. We can request extra hotel nights for you before the program begins.

### Hotel Check-in and Welcome Meeting

Hotel check-in is normally between 2-3 p.m. Check with reception for the exact time and location of the group welcome meeting, typically between 6-7 p.m. Please make every effort to attend this meeting. If you're running late, send a message in the group WhatsApp or call the emergency number on your trip voucher so that your tour leader can let you know where and when to meet the group.

After the meeting, head into the mangrove forest for a firefly watching tour, where thousands of glowing insects light up the trees under the night sky.

### Joining Instructions

Pre-Booked Arrival Transfer: If you purchased a transfer with us, look for a G Adventures representative with a sign displaying your name at the arrivals welcome area. If you are not met or cannot make contact, call the emergency number on your trip voucher or take a taxi to the hotel (save your receipt).

Taxi: (₱170-210 PHP / ~\$3-4 USD | ~10-15 min depending on traffic) Taxis are generally available outside the arrivals area. If you don't see a taxi right away, you can ask airport staff where the taxi stand is located. Ride-hailing apps (like Grab) are not reliably available in Puerto Princesa. Tricycles (similar to Thai tuk-tuks) are actually the dominant local transport.

**Day 2: Puerto Princesa/Port Barton Visit the famous underground river at the UNESCO World Heritage site, Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park. Hop into a boat and cruise through the cave. In the afternoon, drive to Port Barton.**

In the morning, visit the Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the New 7 Wonders of Nature. Take a boat ride through the underground river, exploring its 8.2-kilometer cave system, towering limestone formations, and diverse wildlife, including bats, swallows, and unique flora.

In the afternoon, drive north to Port Barton, a small, peaceful town along Palawan's coast. Known for its crystal-clear waters and quiet beaches, Port Barton is perfect for relaxing or visiting nearby German Island or White Beach. You'll have the chance to unwind and enjoy the atmosphere before continuing your adventure.

**Approximate travel time:** 4 hrs by private vehicle

**Meals included:** Breakfast | Lunch

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### **Day 3: Port Barton Morning boat trip for island hopping with sunbathing, snorkeling for turtles, onboard lunch, and free evening in Port Barton.**

In the morning, board a boat for an island-hopping adventure around the stunning coastline of Port Barton. Spend the day exploring unspoiled beaches, snorkeling in crystal-clear waters, and keeping an eye out for sea turtles. During your adventure, you'll enjoy a lunch on one of these magical islands.

In the evening, head back to Port Barton and unwind at one of the local beach bars. Enjoy the relaxed vibe, sip on a cold drink, and take in the sounds of live music from local bands. The small-town atmosphere comes alive at night, with the soothing rhythm of acoustic guitars and traditional Filipino tunes filling the air. Whether you're enjoying the beach or the lively night scene, it's the perfect way to end your day.

### **Day 4: Port Barton/El Nido Travel from Port Barton to El Nido. Visit Sibaltan Heritage House, participate in cooking demonstration with local women, experience community traditions through songs and dances, and observe Cuyonon weaving.**

Today, we're traveling by private vehicle from Port Barton to El Nido. Upon arrival, head to the village of Sibaltan for a visit to the Sibaltan Heritage House. You'll join local women for a hands-on cooking demonstration and tasting session, as you discover the secret to traditional cuisine.

After lunch, take part in a cultural experience with the community. Learn local songs and dances, and observe Cuyonon artisan weaving using natural materials like pandan and buri leaves. This experience supports sustainable tourism and helps preserve the cultural heritage of the region.

**Approximate travel time:** 3 hrs by private vehicle

**Meals included:** Breakfast | Lunch

### **Day 5: El Nido Private boat tour for island hopping with swimming, snorkeling, and exploring beautiful spots like Secret Beach and Hidden Beach. Keep an eye out for sea turtles, eels, and rays in pristine blue waters around karst formations.**

Spend the day cruising through the breathtaking seascapes of El Nido on a private island-hopping adventure. Set out across Bacuit Bay, known for its limestone karst cliffs, bright turquoise water, and hidden lagoons. Stop at spots like Secret Beach, tucked behind a narrow rock opening, and Hidden Beach, surrounded by towering cliffs. Swim and snorkel through coral reefs teeming with life—keep an eye out for sea turtles, clownfish, and even the occasional stingray gliding beneath the surface.

In between swims, relax on the deck or on the soft white sand of a secluded beach. A freshly prepared lunch will be served on board. Then soak in the scenery and listen to stories about El Nido's geography and history from the crew. After a full day of sun, saltwater, and exploring, head back to shore in the late afternoon and settle in for another peaceful night in Lio Beach.

**Meals included:** Breakfast | Lunch

### **Day 6: El Nido On your last full day in El Nido and the Philippines, relax on a beach, visit Kuyawyaw Falls, or hike Mt. Taraw.**

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Spend your last full day in El Nido however you'd like. Relax on the beach, explore town, or head out on one final adventure. Hike up the jagged limestone cliffs of Taraw Peak for a dramatic panoramic view over Bacuit Bay—just be ready for a steep, hands-on climb. Or take a trip to Kuyawyaw Falls, a series of jungle waterfalls with fresh pools for swimming and cliff-jumping.

Whether you're chasing waterfalls or just soaking up the sun, today's yours to slow down and take it all in before heading home.

**Meals included:** Breakfast

## **Day 7: El Nido Depart El Nido at any time.**

There are no planned activities today, so you may depart El Nido at any time. If you wish to extend your stay, consider booking post-tour accommodation with us.

Please note that check-out time from the hotel is usually mid-morning, but luggage storage services are available at the reception desk.
