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## GEEO ITINERARY

Amalfi Coast 6/5/2027

**Day 1: Naples Arrive in Naples at any time. Meet your group for a welcome meeting around 6:00 or 7:00 p.m.**

**Arrive at any time.** There are no planned activities until the Welcome Meeting in the evening. The nearest airport is the **Naples-Capodichino International Airport (NAP)**.

You can also fly into **Rome's Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport (FCO)**, transfer to Roma Termini train station, and take a 1.5-hour train from Rome to Naples for approximately €60–70 one way (including the Leonardo Express train from the airport to Roma Termini).

### Hotel Check-in and Welcome Meeting

Hotel check-in is normally between 2–3 p.m. Check with reception for the exact time and location of the group welcome meeting, typically between 6–7 p.m. Please make every effort to attend this meeting. If you're running late, send a message in the group WhatsApp or call the emergency number on your trip voucher so that your tour leader can let you know where and when to meet the group.

After the meeting, you might choose to have dinner at a nearby pizzeria with your traveling companions and your tour leader to get to know one another further.

### Joining Instructions

From Naples-Capodichino Airport (NAP): Take a taxi to the hotel for a fixed fare of €21, or take the [Alibus](#) (€5 | ~15min) to Piazza Garibaldi central train station. The hotel is a 5-minute walk from the station.

From Rome Fiumicino Airport (FCO): (€60–70 | ~2.5hrs total) Take the Leonardo Express train from Fiumicino Airport to Roma Termini, then the Frecciarossa high-speed train from Roma Termini to Napoli Centrale. Book tickets at [Trenitalia](#). The hotel is a 5-minute walk from Napoli Centrale.

The [B&B Hotel Napoli](#) is centrally located, has good reviews, and is great for exploring the city's top sights on foot. That said, central Naples, especially the area near the train station, **can feel busy, loud, and rough around the edges**—especially compared to other Italian cities. We recommend following your tour leader's guidance, avoiding wandering alone at night, and using standard city awareness. G Adventures and GEEO travelers have stayed at this hotel for years without incident.

**Day 2: Naples to Sorrento Coast Start with an orientation walk of Naples. Later, the group will travel to Sorrento Coast. In the evening attend a limoncello tasting and after set out on an orientation walk of Sorrento with your tour leader.**

Start the day off with an orientation walk of Naples. Stroll past sites like Spaccanapoli, Castell'Ovo, Castel Nuovo Maschio Angioino, Galleria San Carlo, Piazza del Plebiscito and the Royal Palace.

Then the group will travel to Sorrento Coast. In the evening attend a limoncello tasting and after set out on an orientation walk of Sorrento with your CEO.

**Approximate travel time:** 1–1.5 hours by private vehicle (This drive includes winding, curvy roads. Make sure to pack your preferred medication or remedy for motion sickness and have it handy).

**Meals included:** Breakfast

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### **Day 3: Sorrento Enjoy a free day in Sorrento.**

Enjoy a free day in Sorrento. This small resort town is full of lemons, friendly locals, and cliffs plunging into the sea. Learn about the history and get the lay of the land.

You may opt to go on an excursion to Capri island, and take a stroll through the town while admiring the blue water and striking limestone sea stacks.

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### **Day 4: Sorrento Coast to the Amalfi Coast Travel to the Amalfi Coast.**

Spend the day traveling from the Sorrento Coast to the Amalfi Coast. Pass through the towns of Amalfi and Ravello taking in the dramatic views and searching for lemon groves wherever you go.

**Approximate travel time:** 5 hours by private vehicle, including stops (This drive includes winding, curvy roads. Make sure to pack your preferred medication or remedy for motion sickness and have it handy).

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### **Day 5: Amalfi Coast Head to Bomerano di Agerola along the coast and begin to walk The Path of the Gods. In the afternoon, enjoy free time.**

Head to Bomerano di Agerola along the coast and begin to walk The Path of the Gods. Enjoy views of lemon groves, gorges, deep valleys, woodland, abandoned farmhouses, and the sea below.

*Note that hikes are accessible for all travellers, but there can be sections that are more strenuous and challenging due to terrain. Please ensure you have proper hiking footwear.*

**A note from GEE0:** The exact route your group will take can vary, but if you complete the full hike, expect 8 to 12km over rocky terrain, including well over a thousand stairs along the way. The trail is perfectly doable in tennis shoes or hiking sandals, but make sure the soles have a good grip. Hiking poles and boots can also be rented in Agerola if needed.

The hike ends in Positano, giving you the chance to explore this beautiful town before heading back to rest. A sorbetto al limone is the perfect way to celebrate a long day of hiking along the Amalfi Coast.

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### **Day 6: Amalfi Coast to Naples Leave the Amalfi Coast behind and travel north back to Naples today. Stop in Pompeii for a guided excursion. Enjoy an evening of free time in Naples.**

Leave the Amalfi Coast behind and travel north back to Naples today. Along the way the group will stop in Pompeii for a guided excursion. Walk through the ruins of Pompeii, which was buried under ash and pumice when Mount Vesuvius erupted in 79 AD. The forum, the baths and many houses remain well preserved and provide us with a glimpse of what life was like in the first century.

Enjoy an evening of free time in Naples.

**Approximate travel time:** 1.5-2 hours by private vehicle

**Meals included:** Breakfast

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## Day 7: Naples Depart Naples at any time.

There are no planned activities today, so you may depart Naples at any time. The nearest airport is **Naples-Capodichino International Airport (NAP)**. You can also consider flying to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport (FCO), transferring to Roma Termini, and taking a 1.5-hour train from Roma Termini to Naples for approximately €60-70 one way (including the Leonardo Express train from Roma Termini to the airport); [contact us](#) for more information. If you wish to extend your stay in Naples, consider booking post-tour accommodation with us.

Please note that check-out time from the hotel is usually mid-morning, but luggage storage services are available at the reception desk.
